Call to Order: 6:00P.M.

Approval of /Amendment to Agenda: McCain made a motion to amend the agenda, moving number 1 to 4 (closed session) so people didn't have to wait. 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Dewey, all in favor, motion passed.

Reports: Treasurer supplied report and stated the audit was done.

Clerk: Reported that the trustee position that has been temporarily filled by Robert Sauder, will be placed on the ballot for the August & November elections. The paperwork to file to be on the ballot is available and needs to be turned in by April 17, 2026.

Liquor: Inspection completed and compliance.

Zoning Administrator's report: supplied report, there will be a Zoning Board of Appeals meeting for Chick-Fil-A on March 24, 2026.

Fire Chief: Supplied report, calls were down, no PR events last month, FIT Testing & SCBA Flow testing done, EMS update, Scarbrough asked the fire chief about changing the Fire Board meeting time to later in the day, same day they regularly meet so he can attend. Infrastructure: Supplied report, flush done on 13<sup>th</sup> Street for discolored water, a hydrant was hit, no damage, run water is still in effect.

#3 Cemetery Lawn Care: Double J Lawn Care sent a bid for \$700. Each mow for the year 2026, (last year was \$675.) an increase of \$25. Per Mow. Scarbrough made a motion to accept the bid, 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Dewey, upon roll call vote, all in favor, motion passed.

#4 Closed Session: Scarbrough made a motion to suspend the regular meeting to go into closed session, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Baldwin, all in favor, motion passed, regular meeting was suspended 6:18 PM The regular meeting reconvened @ 6:48 PM.
